Senior Electrical Engineer

Duties and responsibilities

- ✓ Work with 15 kV and 6 kV networks, low voltage networks, instrumentation and control Systems
- ✓ Develop best practice preventative maintenance schedules for the electrical infrastructure
- ✓ Proactive in working with the maintenance team on fault-finding on key equipment and systems
- ✓ Drive implementation of modifications to solve issues or improve plant operations
- ✓ To design, plan and implement electrical projects, in collaboration with the engineering team.
- ✓ Preparation of Tender Documents for the supply and installation of equipment or services.
- ✓ Champion projects and initiatives to reduce specific electricity consumption and plant fixed load
- ✓ To oversee and develop the electrical documentation and drawings system
- ✓ Survey existing electrical equipment with the aim of developing new projects for Capital Expenditure which will keep the Plant in line with BAT and Energy Efficiency
