Health and Safety Officer

Irish Cement Limited is seeking applications for the position Health and Safety Officer in Platin Cement Works, Drogheda, Co. Louth. This is a full-time position for fixed period of 2 years.

It operates two cement-manufacturing facilities, one situated in Platin, approximately 5km from Drogheda, Co. Louth and a second in Castlemungret, Co. Limerick. The successful candidate will report directly to the Platin Health & Safety Manager and be responsible for the following:

- Perform daily job audits to monitor compliance with health and safety policy.
- Coach employees and contractors at the job site on risk evaluation and reduction.
- Work with the team to drive awareness and improvement throughout the Plant in the areas of Health, Safety and Welfare.
- Advise management on the actions needed to reduce the levels of occupational risk.
- Document and enhance job specific Risk Assessments with the relevant teams.
- Develop accident reduction and prevention programmes.
- Enhance procedures for dealing with contractors coming on to the site.
- Complete induction programmes for contractors & staff coming on site.
- Continuously review Health & Safety Policy / Safety Statements and recommend revisions / amendments as appropriate.
- Design and deliver Toolbox Talks.

- Participate in and ensure that an effective consultation mechanism is maintained within the company for health and safety.

The above list is not exhaustive. The successful candidate will be expected to perform duties as necessitated by the changing role and the overall business objectives of the Company, as directed.

Essential Qualifications, Knowledge and Experience:

This is a site focused role. The candidate should be self motivated, highly committed and enthusiastic. Strong interpersonal skills and an ability to communicate effectively with a cross-functional work force is essential.
